What is a Baby Signs® ICI?

ICIs are individuals, at least 21 years of age, who are trained and certified to offer a variety of Baby Signs[®] classes in their communities. Baby Signs[®] ICIs are parents, educators, speech and language pathologists, child development professionals and those who simply enjoy working with children and families. They may also be individuals who work for children's health, educational or family service agencies/organizations who offer Baby Signs® workshops and classes to the families and child service professionals their agency serves.

Is the ICI opportunity right for me?

If you answer "yes" to any of the following questions, becoming a Baby Signs[®] ICI may be just the opportunity you are looking for! Would you like to:

- make a difference in the lives of babies?
- help spread the good news about signing with babies?
- set your own work hours?
- launch a fun and rewarding business of your own?
- offer families a research-based program that is fun and exciting?

What Makes the Baby Signs® Program Unique?

For over 25 years, the *Original* Baby Signs[®] Program has brought the joys and benefits of signing with babies to millions of families around the world. The Baby Signs[®] Program is the world's leading sign language program for hearing babies because it is the only program:

- created by child development experts
- developed specifically for hearing babies
- created by child development experts
- with proven benefits backed by scientific research
- with a flexible approach to ensure success for all families

<u>Does the Baby Signs® Program use American Sign Language</u> (ASL)?

The Baby Signs® Program is ASL based. About 90% of the recommended signs are ASL, a few of which have been slightly modified to make them easier for babies. The remaining 10% are not ASL; they are signs that are recommended because they more closely match babies' experiences (e.g., picking up Cheerios rather than eating cereal with a spoon).

Because my father-in-law is Deaf, all his grandchildren were taught to sign. I was the first one, though, that had heard about the Baby Signs Program and could try it with my own daughter. My father-in-law was so impressed with how easily she learned the signs at such a young age that he's now a *super* big fan and recommends the program to every parent he meets.

Early Childhood Educator (ECE) Training

Program Description

The goal of this program is to help child care programs and family service agencies (such as non-profit organizations, hospitals, nanny agencies, child care resource and referral services, etc.) learn how to easily incorporate the Baby Signs® Program into their existing early childhood and parenting programs and their community outreach efforts. The ECE Training is a 3-hour staff training program that upon completion certifies the center or organization to become a Baby Signs® Certified Center. The ECE Training is delivered using the Center Certification Program (CCP), a video-based training that enables centers and organizations to train their staff with or without a Baby Signs® Instructor conducting the training.

The CCP provides everything needed to deliver a successful training, so no previous experience is required. Experienced ICIs, on the other hand, may choose to rely less heavily on the video presentation and deliver the information themselves.



Offering the ECE Training: ICIs can offer the ECE Training in two ways. Both options are described below.

Option 1

The first option is to sell the CCP directly to centers or organizations so that they may self-train and become certified. ICIs can purchase the CCP for \$125 and then resell it to the center at the retail price of \$250. The instructor's profit would then be \$125.

Option 2

The second option is for an ICI to deliver a live, face-to-face ECE Training, the method most often requested by organizations. To offer a live training, ICIs must complete the ECE Training certification requirements.

The Center Certification Program (CCP) can be left with the center so that they may train future staff or use the materials as review tools.

Steps to ECE Training Certification

- 1) Purchase the ECE Training Instructor Package (\$125)
- 2) Review the CCP materials including the Handbook, files and videos.
- 3) Submit Training Completion Form.



Manners, Mealtime, & More!

Program Description

Good manners do more than impress people. They also express gratitude and promote harmonious interactions. Helping children learn these social skills is important because kids who feel grateful and treat others well are more empathic, get along better with peers and adults, and feel more satisfied with life than those who don't. Manners are best taught through example, and mealtime provides many opportunities. Because manners are abstract ideas, including simple signs can make the concepts more concrete for young children. That's the purpose of this class. Additionally, increasing a child's mealtime vocabulary reduces frustration by enabling him/her to be more precise in expressing likes and dislikes—resulting in more harmonious mealtimes!
