What Is a Baby Signs[®] ICI?

ICIs are trained and certified professionals, at least 21 years of age, who teach Baby Signs classes in their communities. They come from a variety of backgrounds — parents, educators, speech-language pathologists, early interventionists, and others who enjoy working with children and families. They may also be individuals who work for children's health, educational or family service agencies/organizations, who offer workshops and classes to the families and child service professionals their agency serves.

Yes! The Baby Signs® Program is ASL-based. About 90% of the recommended signs are ASL, a few of which have been slightly modified to make them easier for babies. The remaining 10% are not ASL; they are signs that are recommended because they more closely match babies' experiences (e.g., picking up Cheerios rather than eating cereal with a spoon).

Flexibility is one of the hallmarks of the Baby Signs Program. Families are encouraged to use whatever signs work for them, including their baby's own creations. After all, the signing research cited most frequently by those in the infant



The Early Childhood Educator (ECE) Training helps child care programs and family service agencies—such as non-profit organizations and child care resource and referral services—easily incorporate the Baby Signs® Program into their early childhood classrooms, parenting programs, and community outreach efforts.

This 3-hour, video-based staff training program certifies participating centers and organizations, as **Baby Signs® Certified Centers** upon completion. The ECE Training uses the **Center Certification Program (CCP)**—a comprehensive, self-contained training package that enables agencies to train their staff with or without an instructor present.

- ECE Instructor Training: \$125 (optional, purchased separately)
- Suggested Facilitator Fee: \$250+
- Includes: Center Certification Program (CCP) videos, training resources, Staff Training Guide, digital classroom resources, and Video Dictionary



Offering the ECE Training:

Certified Instructors can offer the ECE Training in two ways:

Option 1 – Sell the CCP directly to centers or organizations

ICIs may purchase the CCP for \$125 and resell it to the center at the retail price of \$250, earning a profit of \$125 per sale. The center can then use the CCP to train its staff independently.

Option 2 - Deliver a live, in-person ECE Training

ICIs may conduct an on-site ECE Training for staff groups. To offer this option, instructors must first complete the ECE Training certification requirements. The CCP may be left with the center for future training or ongoing staff development.
